### **Aim**

The DCTC recognizes the time and effort required to travel to our club for competitions. This document is designed to help ensure a smooth and stress-free stay for all participants.

### **Sites**

Due to electrical supply limitations, the club can offer only 10 powered sites. Additionally, DCTC provides 10 non-powered sites, with the possibility of more depending on available space. Every effort will be made to accommodate your site preference, whether powered or non-powered or next to a friend. If a requested site becomes available, you may be offered the option to switch.

### **Booking**

To book a site, please complete this form and submit to [dctcsecretary@gmail.com](mailto:dctcsecretary@gmail.com). The secretary will confirm your booking via email. The club does not require a deposit. However, if your plans change, we kindly ask that you notify us as soon as possible.

### **Early Arrival and Cancellations**

We understand that plans change, and you may arrive earlier than expected. You are welcome to arrive before your scheduled date. Please notify the secretary as early as possible so we can accommodate your arrival.

## Payment

All camping spaces are \$40 per night, subject to change without notice.

The club appreciates payment being made before departure. Any outstanding payments will be issued a valid tax invoice.

## Right of Refusal

Please be mindful that DCTC is a volunteer run club. We reserve the right to refuse or terminate bookings or evict guests if they fail to comply with these terms and conditions or pose a health and safety risk.

## Rules, Guidelines and Safety

You must always:

- Follow instructions regarding your allocated camping space.
- Follow instructions on what taps can be used for water supply.
- Take responsibility for your own safety and the safety of others.
- Safely stow your possessions. The club does not take responsibility for valuables, goods or vehicles.
- Keep your allocated space clean.
- Dispose of rubbish in designated bins.
- Supervise minors to ensure their safety.

## Animals

You are permitted to bring animals with you to the club. Dogs are to be controlled as per the [Dog Management Policy](#).

Additional to this:

- Animals are not to be bathed in the bathrooms or sinks.
- Animals are not to disturb other campers and must be kept under control.

## Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the buildings or on the clubhouse veranda.

## Help around the club

Any help around the club during events is appreciated but not expected. DCTC would like you to enjoy your stay. However, if you would like to assist in any way please speak to the president beforehand.

## Cleaning of vehicles and dump points

Please refrain from washing vehicles and vans while camping at the club.

The club **does not** have a waste dump facility. **Do not** use the club toilets as a dump point. Any blockages caused will result in the responsible party being charged for the plumber's call-out fee.

Closest dump point is located at the Darwin Greyhound Club.
