

# **Dog Management Policy**

# **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to manage the presence of dogs within the Darwin Clay Target Club Inc. (DCTC) grounds, ensuring a safe, enjoyable, and clean environment for all users. This policy provides uniform standards on where dog/s are permitted, and the conduct required by owners.

# Scope

This policy applies to all areas within DCTC ground including, but not limited to:

- Shooting walks
- Spectator seating areas
- Buildings and
- Car parks.

### **Definitions**

- **Owner:** person the dog is registered to, including and not limited to, the person who is in control of the dog at any given time.
- Assistance dog: any dog that is qualified, accredited, and serving the person they are with.
- Leash: including chain, cord or another device to tether the dog.
- Collar: including harness or halter.

### **General Guidelines**

#### **Behavioral Expectations**

- Dogs must be well-behaved and not cause disturbance to other users of the grounds if this should occur the owner is to remove the dog from the area.
- Anti-social behavior, including but not limited to, aggressive behavior, excessive barking, or other disruptive actions will result in the owner being asked to remove the dog from the premises.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring their dog is not posing a threat to other animals or people at any time.

#### **Leash Requirements**

- All dogs must be kept on a leash attached to an appropriately fitted collar which must be in good condition.
- Owners must always maintain control of their dog.
- Campers during competitions are to tether their dogs on a leash at the camp site.

# **Off- Leash Requirements**

- Dogs are permitted off their leash when competition is completed, and competitors have left the facility.
- While off the leash the owner must actively supervise the dog and always maintain a clear and unobstructed view of the dog.
- The dog must remain within 50m of the owner so that it is in visual and audible range to allow for effective recall at any time.
- The owner must carry a leash which is to be placed on the dog when necessary.

#### **Prohibited Areas**

- Dogs are prohibited from entering certain areas of DCTC grounds including:
  - On or near the walks during competition or training sessions
  - Food service areas
  - Inside buildings
  - Seating areas outside of the club house.

# **Cleaning Up After Dogs**

- Dog owners are required to always clean up after their dog.
- Failure to clean up after dogs will result in restrictions on future access to the grounds.

## **Assistance Dogs**

 Assistance dogs are permitted in all areas of the grounds where dogs are typically prohibited, provided they are under control and appropriately leashed.

### **Penalties and Enforcement**

Non-compliance with this policy will result in:

- A warning
- Fines
- Revocation of dog access to the grounds
- Removal of the dog from the premises.

# **Policy Review**

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure its effectiveness and to address any issues or concerns raised by dog owners, non-dog owners, and ground management.
